**of the International Relations Department of Institute of Mathematics and
Mechanics for 2016**

The international relations Department operates in the Institute of Mathematics and Mechanics from January 2016 and carries out its activities in establishing close scientific relations with foreign scientific centers and organizations. The scope of activities of the Department is to search of ways to cooperation with foreign scientific, educational and industrial organizations, Institutions, academic institutions and innovative companies for the promotion of scientific results and products of the Institute on the international scientific market.

During the reporting period, the Institute signed a number of international agreements with leading academic institutions of the Russian Federation, Ukraine, Italy, India, and China.
